What Makes a Home Healthy





Eligibility

- Privately owned housing
- 100% AMI = Family of 4 up to \$85,500
- Affordable Rent = No more than 30% Annual Income

A Price Everyone Likes

- Provide and install smoke detector(s) and a carbon monoxide alarm Free of charge
- Provide a child safety kit including cabinet locks, door handle covers, etc. Free of charge



Healthy Home Assessment









Falls, Falls, Falls

- Fractures
- Head Injuries
- Bruising
- Death
- Level Surfaces
 - 23% of units with hazards
- Between levels
 - 30% of units with hazards
- On Stairs
 - 48% of units with hazards







Other Typical Hazards

- Mold & Moisture Black Mold to Mushrooms
- Electrical Hazards Outlets to Upgrades
- Structural Issues Porch Roofs to Whole Stair Systems
- Pests Cockroaches to Raccoons



How We Fix Hazards

- Install Dryer vents; Bathroom Exhaust Fans
- Install safety devices (Smoke Alarm & CO Monitor)
- Asbestos Abatement
- Replace Furnaces
- Install Hand Railings; Grab Bars in Shower
- Install GFCI Outlets
- Replace Roof Porch
- Integrated Pest Management
